3 Gaited, Fine Harness, 3 Gaited Country Pleasure, Park Horse, Saddle Type Western  
5 Gaited, Park Pleasure, Show Pleasure, Country Western & Hunt Seat & Parade, Saddle Seat Equitation

This applies to the Five Gaited, 3 Gaited, Fine Harness, Park Horse, & Park Pleasure Classes.

Open, Junior Horse, 2 & 3 Year Old, Maiden, Limit & Novice Classes To be judged: performance, presence, quality, manners & conformation. Ladies Class to be judged: manners, quality, presence, performance & conformation. Amateur & Junior Exhibitor Classes: To be judged: Manners, performance, presence, quality & conformation.

Grand Championship: To be judged 75% performance, presence, quality & manners, 25% on total conformation.

The Open/Ohio Owned Stakes : If you are eligible to compete as both Ohio Owned & Open entry if you pay both entry fees you will be eligible for premiums for both classes. If the 1<sup>st</sup> place horse is not eligible for the Ohio Owned premiums the first horse that places that is Ohio Owned gets the Ohio Owned 1<sup>st</sup> place premium. The 3 Gaited Saddlebred should be the epitome of beauty, brilliance, elegance, refinement and expression. Its gaits are collected and its energy directed toward animation and precision. It is shown with a roached mane & tail. 2 Year olds may show with a full mane & tail. To be shown at an animated walk, park, trot and canter both ways of the ring.

## American Saddlebred Fine Harness

The Fine Harness horse should possess all of the elegance and refinement of the ideal American Saddlebred and its energy should be directed toward animation rather than speed. To be shown with a full mane & tail to an appropriate vehicle with light harness with blinkers, snaffle bit and overcheck are required. To enter the ring at a park trot. To be shown at an animated walk, park trot and "show your horse" (except in Ladies, Junior Exhibitor, Amateur or Amateur Owner Classes "Show your horse" will not be called for. Horses should stand quietly in the lineup, but may not be required to back. Headers may stand the horses up on their feet, but must remain 2 paces from the head when entry is being judged. Attendant may stand just inside the gait during Ladies, Junior Exhibitor, Amateur or Amateur Owner classes, but must take no action that will affect the performance of any horse.

The Pleasure horse should be a typical Saddlebred with quality, style, presence and suitable conformation; prompt, comfortable gaits, giving the distinct impression it is an agreeable mount to ride. Easy ground covering action is desirable. Manners and suitability as a Pleasure horse are paramount.

Special emphasis is placed on a true, flat walk. Transitions from one gait to another should be smooth and effortless.

## American Saddlebred Show Pleasure Driving

To be shown to a two-wheeled jog cart with driver only at a flat walk, trot and extended trot, extreme speed to be penalized. Light harness with snaffle and separate overcheck bit is required. To stand quietly and back readily in the lineup. One attendant without whip is permitted to head each horse during the lineup. The header may stand the entry on its feet and then MUST STAND THREE PACES BACK FROM THE HORSE: only allowed to

touch the horse for safety purposes. To be judged 75% manners, performance, presence and quality; 25% total conformation.

## American Saddlebred Country Pleasure Section

The Pleasure horse should be a typical Saddlebred with quality, style, presence and suitable conformation and prompt, comfortable gaits; giving the distinct impression it is an agreeable mount to ride. Easy ground covering action is desirable. Manners and suitability as a Pleasure horse are paramount. Special emphasis is placed on a true, flat walk. Transitions from one gait to another should be smooth and effortless.

## American Saddlebred Country Pleasure Driving

To be shown to a suitable two-wheeled vehicle with appropriate harness. To be shown at a flat walk, trot and extended trot, speed to be penalized. Entries must be asked to halt and stand on the rail both ways of the ring. Entries must stand quietly and back readily in the line up. One attendant without whip is permitted to head each horse during the line up. The header may stand the entry on its feet. Then **MUST STAND THREE PACES BACK FROM THE HORSE AND ONLY ALLOWED TO TOUCH THE HORSE FOR SAFETY PURPOSES.**
