Contestants may enter up to three classes: individual, the pair's class and the costume class. If entering more than one class, a separate entry form must be used for each entered.

- Individual Class (\$10 entry fee — one person/one sheep) Costume Class (see exhibitor information for rules)

- Pair Class (\$20 entry fee — both participants under the age of 10)
- Pair Class (\$20 entry - at least one (1) participant is age 10 or older) Make checks payable to: **Ohio State Fair**

COMMENTARY INFORMATION: Must be typed and double spaced. Handwritten commentaries **WILL NOT** be accepted. The commentary must fit on the back of this form - no extra pages allowed. Please print/type your commentary on the back of this form. Your commentary should be written as you want it read during the show as if it were being told about you. Use your name, he or she in the commentary instead of "I or me". Your commentary should include: (1) Introduction and Sheep Experience (limit of 80 words) - your name, hometown and experience with sheep; (2) Description of Outfit (limit of 80 words) - describe the outfit you are wearing, including accessories; and (3) List breed, age of sheep and sponsor (if applicable) and any sheep accessories. Sheep pedigree is not needed - (limit of 30 words)

No commentary changes will be accepted the day of the contest.
