

**DIVISION 10
SHOWMANSHIP**

PURPOSE

The purpose of a Showmanship Contest is to encourage young exhibitors to acquire skill and know-how in the handling of animals and to obtain information and practice in fitting and grooming them for show.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Entry in showmanship is not required in any department.

2. When two classes of showmanship are scheduled, Junior Showmanship is open to exhibitors who have not passed their 15th birthday as of January 1. Senior Showmanship is open to exhibitors who have passed their 15th birthday as of January 1. If more than two classes are offered, see age classification for breed within specific departments, age determined as of January 1 of current year.

3. Each contestant must fit and show his/her own animal, but during the course of the contest may be asked by the judge to show some other animal.

4. The animal used for showmanship must be one entered and shown by the exhibitor in respective production or market class in Junior Fair.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

In judging Showmanship Contests the judge will consider these major points of emphasis:

1. The judge will observe the general all around ability and know-how the contestant demonstrates in the training and handling of animals, and the manner in which he/she presents his animal.

2. The judge will be looking for contestants who demonstrate they know how to handle themselves in the show ring.

3. The judge will be looking for evidence that the contestants know how to fit and groom an animal. But grooming alone will not be emphasized.

4. The judge will appraise the contestant's knowledge and use of good show ring equipment as demonstrated by the equipment used and the skill in using it.

5. The judge will appraise the extent the contestant demonstrates knowledge of accepted show ring practices and customs, and may ask questions relating to animal production.

PROJECT RECORD BOOK CONTEST

Recognition will be awarded to participants in the following skillathons:

A) Youth entered as 4-H members must bring their up to date Species Record Books (Beef #117, Swine #139 or #140, Sheep #198 or #199, or respective 4-H Poultry book, #151, #152, #153, #166, or #168). Copies of 4-H record books will not be accepted. 4-H project record books will be allowed no more than 7 additional sheets of paper (single or double-sided) and those pages must pertain directly to activities or records required for the book. 4-H project record books must be intact. The project record book pages cannot be separated and/or placed loose or in sheet protectors in a binder. The record book may be put into a binder if additional pages are added, with the additional pages placed in the binder proceeding the intact project record book.

B) Youth entered as FFA members must bring an up-to-date Animal Enterprise Record Book or Farm Account Book for each species entered. Other record books that contain equivalent record keeping information are acceptable.

Judging criteria will include evidence of a working record, completeness, accuracy and how well the book reflects sound production and management practices. Interviews on the record book may be required for finalists.

AWARDS

Awards will be given to the 1st place Record Book winner in each age division (9-18) from each of the four (4) species competitions listed above. There will not be an overall winner selected for the Junior Fair Project Record Book Contest in each species. A total of 40 awards will be presented to the 10 age division winners in each of the 4 categories listed above.

The Ed Zorn Family, in memory of Ed Zorn, will provide awards for the first place age division winners in the Junior Fair Project Record Book Contests in Sheep.

Mark & Jeanette List will provide awards for the first place age division winners in the Junior Fair Project Record Book Contests in Swine and Poultry.

The Ohio Limousin Association in memory of Pam Beam Manino, will provide awards for the first place age division winners in the Junior Fair Project Record Book Contest in Beef.

OUTSTANDING MARKET PROJECT FINALISTS

In 2017, twelve (12) finalists for junior fair Outstanding Market Project will receive money from the Youth Reserve Program. The 4th through 10th place winners will also receive money from the Youth Reserve Program.
