



The Ohio State Fair will host the 4th annual **Buckeye State Sanctioned Kiddy Pedal Tractor Pullers Championship** on August 6, 2017 at 3p in the Sheep Barn (registration starts at 10a-3p).

Owners of the Buckeye State Kiddy Pedal Tractor Pullers, Gary and Rochelle Daiber of Bucyrus, Ohio, started as full time pullers in 2012 and are proud members of the National Pedal Pullers Association (NPPA) along with approximately 20 other states throughout the U.S. The Buckeye State Pedal Tractor Pullers is committed to advancing the recognition of the sport of children's pedal tractor pulling throughout Ohio and at the national level by facilitating the development of children's ability to compete fairly, showing good sportsmanship and having fun with all children to build lasting memories.

This pedal tractor pulling event encourages children 4-12 to pedal a 1/6 scale tractor pulling a weight transfer sled as far as they can, with the longest pull winning the event. These pedal tractors have been modified (beefed up) to take the everyday pounding of today's youngsters. And yes, there is a modified pedal pulling tractor for those 13 and over as well.

Children participating in approximately 60 pulling events during the 2016 - 2017 season that win the 3 top places in each age group 4-11 will qualify and be invited to the State Pull Championship.

Girls and boys in each age group 4-12 (depending on birth date) will pull separately in classes to determine the winners. The top 3 in each class will qualify and be invited to the National Kiddy Pedal Tractor Pulling Championships held in September at the Corn Palace in Mitchell, South Dakota.
