

Instructions for Completing Ohio State Fair Junior Dog Division 901 Online Entries

Deadline: Midnight (12:00am) Saturday June 20

GENERAL

1. ALL entries for the Junior Fair Dog Show July 31 – August 1, MUST be made online at <https://ohiostatefair.com/livestock/>
2. An online entry tutorial will be posted prior to entries opening at <http://www.ohiostatefair.com/index.php/competitions-37/agriculturelivestock/jr-livestock>.
3. Entries must be made by midnight Sunday, June 20. DO NOT wait until the last minute! The system cuts entries off at midnight and slows down as more users are logged on.
4. Late entries will NOT be accepted for the July 31 – August 1 Dog Show.
5. There are NO refunds for classes dropped. Please make sure your entry is correct before submitting.

ENTRY FEES AND ADMISSION TICKETS

1. Entry fees are \$5.00 per class per dog.
2. If you are unsure of the classes in which you plan to show, it is better to pay the \$5.00 to enter a class you are unsure of so you will be eligible to show in that class.
3. Ticketing and Parking Pricing and Information - There will be no admission charge in 2021. Parking will be charged. The cost for parking is \$50 for 6 days and \$75 for the full fun of the event. There is no pre-purchase for parking.

LOGGING IN

1. We recommend you do not use your phone to make online entries as it is harder to complete the entry process correctly. Enter using a computer if possible.
2. Every year is called a new year, even if you are not a first-time exhibitor. You must begin the online entry system as a new exhibitor. Once on the start page, if you are a returning exhibitor, check the "I'm Returning" box and enter your password. You can enter online as early as April as a new exhibitor and go in to make changes as a returning exhibitor up until the June 20 deadline.
3. New exhibitors must create a password.
4. Write down your password. If you forget your password you must contact Barb Prince, Entry Dept., at B.Prince@expo.ohio.gov.

ENTERING EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

1. The following is the information asked when you set up your online account: First Name, Last Name, Address, City, State, Zip Code, County, Phone, Email, Jr. Exhibitor DOB, Age, 4-H Agent's Name (this is your 4-H Educator's name), FFA Teacher's Name (if taking a dog project through FFA), 4-H/FFA County (your county of 4-H or FFA enrollment where you are taking your dog project).
2. For the 4-H Educator section, it is important the 4-H educator's name is correct. DO NOT PUT THE NAME OF YOUR 4-H ADVISOR. To help you know your county 4-H educator's name: FILL IN THE BLANK: The name of my 4-H educator is _____.
3. New in 2021 Shirt size is for all Junior Fair Exhibitors -enter your shirt size in the appropriate box

ENTERING DOG INFORMATION

1. If you are showing more than one dog, when you have completed the first dog's information the system will ask if you want to enter another. You must make separate entries for each dog you are showing. This is also true for the Brace class: 53R. You must make a separate entry for each dog.
2. Dog information requested includes: Class (that is the class number), Animal Name (please use dog's call name, not registered name if applicable), Breed, Dog's Age, Sex, and Jump Height.
3. Pay close attention to class numbers and days! There will be a class number (ranging from 01-35) and a class letter indicating which day a class is offered: S=Saturday, U=Sunday. (i.e. 07S = Rally Novice A on Saturday, 30U = Rally Novice A on Sunday)

CHECKING OUT

1. Double check all classes before checking out.
2. Review the classes you marked on the worksheet below to double check your entries.
3. Payment must be made using a credit card.
4. When checking out you will be asked to pay for all dogs entered.
5. MAKE SURE YOU PRINT OFF YOUR RECEIPT! Or take a screen shot or picture with your phone.
6. The receipt will also show the list of classes you entered. Keep this for your records!

WORKSHEET

1. Refer to the worksheet below for classes (class numbers/days) offered. **THE ONLINE ENTRY FORM WILL NOT LOOK LIKE THE WORKSHEET!**
2. Fill out the classes by marking an "X" in front of the class(es) you plan to enter.
3. It is suggested you complete this during a 4-H club meeting with the help of your advisor. Make sure your advisor approves of the classes entered. You must be a member in good standing in your county to enter at the State Fair. You and your dog must also be prepared/eligible to perform the exercises in each class you to enter. The State Fair Dog Show is where you showcase your skills, not practice them!
4. Use the classes you marked on this worksheet when entering online.
