ATTENTION ALL EXHIBITORS 2021 Updates for the Ractopamine Free Ohio State Fair.

- We will be a ractopamine free fair.
- Exhibitor Affidavit for the Market Barrow Show will be required
- Market Barrows will be required to have an 840 Tag. We prefer that they be the EID (Electronic Identification) 840 Tags but will accept non EID this year. These should be placed in the pig from the breeder they originate from, if possible please have them placed in the RIGHT EAR. If you do not have one, you will want to work with your local vet.
- All Market Exhibitors will be required to enter parent/guardian PQA Certification ID# at the time of entry.
- All swine must be tagged with an 840 tag.
- **All exhibitors must have a premise ID** (this is based on the location the pigs were raised, so the same premise ID will cover all siblings). Please go to <https://agri.ohio.gov/wps/portal/gov/oda/divisions/animal-health/animal-id/premise-registration-form-fillable840tags> or getting a premise ID, please talk to your veterinarian.

EXHIBITING A RACTOPAMINE-FREE SWINE PROJECT

RACTOPAMINE-FREE SWINE PRODUCTION IS NOW A MARKET SPECIFICATION/REQUIREMENT THROUGHOUT MUCH OF THE U.S. PORK PACKING INDUSTRY. BECAUSE SHOW PIGS HAVE THE POTENTIAL TO ENTER INTERNATIONAL PORK MARKETS, THEY MUST BE RACTOPAMINE-FREE.

EXPECT YOUR FAIR TO SECURE A SIGNED AFFIDAVIT FROM A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN STATING THAT THE PIGS EXHIBITED BY THEIR SHOWMAN HAVE NEVER BEEN OFFERED RACTOPAMINE.



WHAT IS RACTOPAMINE?

A beta-adrenergic agonist that when fed according to label directions can improve pig growth rate, carcass composition, and feed conversion efficiency. Product trade names include: Paylean®, Optaflexx®, Engain®, Actogain®, and other generic derivatives.



WHAT DOES RACTOPAMINE-FREE MEAN?

The pig has never been fed or exposed to ractopamine sources from the time of birth to the time of harvest.



AREAS OF FOCUS TO ENSURE YOUR PROJECT IS RACTOPAMINE-FREE

1. YOUR PIG

Understand the status of any pig(s) you purchase or raise on your own farm and comply by not feeding or exposing your pigs to ractopamine.

2. YOUR FEED SUPPLY

Work directly with your feed supplier to assure that the feed you use is free of ractopamine.

3. YOUR FEEDERS

Feeders and containers should be thoroughly disinfected and dried prior to adding new feed. This will prevent cross-contamination.

4. YOUR BARN

Pens, bedding, fans, etc. should be thoroughly disinfected as they have a risk of containing ractopamine if you have fed it in the past.

5. YOUR TRAILER

Do a complete disinfection and drying of trailers and vehicles between loads of pigs.

6. EXHIBITION

Don't offer ractopamine if the rules indicate it is not acceptable for the fair or exhibition.

SESSION 1 and 2 INFORMATION BREEDING SWINE ENTERING PROCEDURE

- Ownership deadline: June 1. All entries must be in the name of the actual owner or partnership. All animals must be owned by June 1. Animals must have been transferred to or be registered in the name of the exhibitor at time of check-in.
- Entry Fee is \$30 a head
- **Entries close on June 20.** Open Class entries MUST be done online. **Online entries through www.ohiostatefair.com.**
 - Exhibitors should retain a record of their exact login information (username and password).
 - If entering under farm name, please utilize team/ company information line to list your farm name.
- Breeding gilt entries must include Breed, Registration number, sex, sire, sire of dam, birth date, ear notch, and session number.
- Registration papers for all purebred gilts and boars are required. (See Ownership Guidelines for more details). Registration Information is required at entry.
- Registration papers must be presented at the time of check-in. Originals required. No copies accepted.
- All breeding swine must be ear notched. Registration papers will be checked with ear notches of animals before animals can be shown.
- Exhibitor's name on entry must be exactly the same as owner's name listed on registration papers. Variations of ownership would require separate entries. Partnership and family owned pedigrees will be accepted.
- Substitutions may ONLY be made within *BREED* at the time of check in.
- If entering both Junior and Open, you MUST complete entry online for BOTH JR and OPEN, online entry.
- There is no limit to entries made, number of animals shown, or the number of premiums won by an exhibitor in any Open Breeding Swine Classes. **Only exception-** Youth Crossbred Gilts, which are limited to 6 entries (paying the stated entry fee) and 3 additional substations (at no charge). However only 6 may show at the fair.
- Purebred breeding swine (gilts and boars), crossbred boars and crossbred gilts that are in the sale must provide a health certificate.
- **Late Entries OPEN CLASS only after June 20** - you will need to email Barb Prince at b.prince@expo.ohio.gov. Email must include exhibitor's information, classes entering and any other information required by your species.
 - *OPEN BREEDING SWINE LATE ENTRY ONLY* (June 21-July 20) requires a \$75.00 late fee per exhibitor, per species, plus the usual per animal charge.

Session 1 & 2 BREEDING SWINE OWNERSHIP AND AGE GUIDELINES

- All animals must be owned by June 1. Animals must have been transferred to or registered in the name of the exhibitor at time of check-in.
- All Breeding Gilts must have been farrowed on or after December 1, 2020. Breeding gilt classes will be shown by age; youngest to oldest.

EXHIBITION

- Pen assignment request will be taken on Sunday, July 25. Tickets for your spot in line can be picked up beginning at 8am on Sunday, July 25 at the Ohio State Fair Swine Barn Office. NO BARN LINES. We are working on an online system, if available prior to the fair, information will be sent to all exhibitors via email used in online entry.
- All pens are assigned by the Swine Department personnel. Exhibitors must check for correct pen assignments before bedding down. Exhibits incorrectly located will need to move to assigned area. If exhibitor fails to follow pen assignments, they will be asked to leave.
- Pen space limited to pigs only. NO TACK or FEED in pens. Boards may be put across the top of pens for tack and feed storage. Pens are approximately 5' x 7'.
- Each exhibitor must furnish his own feed troughs, buckets, etc. Feed and bedding will not be furnished, but will be available for purchase. The feed store phone number will be available in the office.
- Exhibitors should arrange to feed their animals between 6:00 am - 8:00 am and 5:00 pm - 7:00 pm

The Ohio State Fair will follow the Ohio Department of Agriculture Livestock Exhibition Rules.

- No oil or oil-like show dressing will be permitted at the Ohio State Fair during the show. **Water is the preferred and accepted dressing**
- Powder and whitewash will not be allowed on Chester White, Landrace and Yorkshire,
- Poland China will not be permitted to use paint, powder or oil at the Ohio State Fair.
- The use of the above will result in forfeiture of premiums.
- Any breed failing to exhibit a total of 15 animals in the breeding classes will be cause for evaluation of continuing this breed in future shows.
- Anyone showing a boar must be 18 or older or have a written parent consent at check-in.

AWARDS

- Animals in each class will be placed on a 1-2-3-4 etc. basis and the premiums as listed will be paid on the numerical placing. The placing premiums will be announced at a later date.
- All Champion Open Boars and Gilts must sell, if a breed sale is offered. Any Champion or Reserve Champion Junior Fair Gilt may sell.
- Class size breakdown. Gilt classes will be divided by a maximum of 12 head per class plus or minus three (3) head. All classes will be shown youngest to oldest. Boar classes will be divided by a maximum of six (6) per class plus or minus two (2) head. All classes will show youngest to oldest.

BARROW ENTERING PROCEDURE

- Ownership deadline: **May 26**. All entries must be in the name of the actual owner or partnership. All animals must be **owned by May 26**. Animals must have been transferred to or be registered in the name of the exhibitor at time of check-in.
- *ENTER ALL (PUREBRED AND CROSSBRED) BARROWS IN each of their respective breed specific classes, Division 1612*
- Entries close on June 20 and MUST be done online:
 - Online entries through www.ohiostatefair.com is the method of entering. Exhibitors should retain a record of their exact login information (username and password).
 - If entering under farm name, please utilize team/ company information line to list your farm name.
- Entries must include exhibitors name, complete address, and entry fees.
- A maximum of six (6) head of market barrows, may be shown, additional entries (up to 3) may be made as substitutions.
- It is mandatory all purebred barrows have individual registration papers at check-in. All registration information must be provided at the time of entry.
- All barrows will be divided into classes after check-in on August 4. All weights must be declared within 2 hours of check-in. Weights cannot be changed after declaration.
- Any breed exhibiting less than 12 animals will be combined with the next smallest breed. All purebred barrows and crossbred barrows will then be placed in classes with a maximum of 16 head per class.
Example: 16 and under – 1 class; Over 17 – 2 classes

DIVISION 1612 BARROW SHOW- NO LATE ENTRIES

All barrows MUST enter into Division 1612, you will be entering barrows this year by breed class and list breed, 840 Tag ID #, ear notch, Sire, Sire of Dam, registration # (if purebred), and declaring/acknowledging your barrow has been and will be ractopamine free. Barrows have a limit of six (6) head to be exhibited at \$30 per head. You may enter an additional three (3) barrows as possible substitutions at no additional charge. All barrows will be entered into their respective breed classes. Exhibitors will identify and confirm the 6 head maximum at check-in and will be confirmed in proper classes at this point. NO LATE ENTRIES.

When entering a barrow into either Dark Cross barrow or Other Cross Barrow classes, you will need to enter the registration number as "0000". It is a required field and we understand you will not have a registration number for those barrows. Please use the number "0000" for those barrows.

Upon arrival at the Ohio State Fair exhibitor MUST declare which barrow(s) will be shown. The entry/entries must be confirmed by the Ohio State Fair staff at check-in using the original entry list to confirm. If barrow identification does NOT match original entry information, entry will not be eligible for show.

RULES

- Premiums per class will be determined at a later date.
- Judges will disqualify barrows showing evidence of late castration, cryptorchidism, or serious structural defects, regardless of the apparent muscling or degree of finish shown.
- After declaration of weight, judging sheets and programs will be printed listing each of the exhibitors' barrows placed in the proper breed and weight class.
- Registration papers and breed standards are required for purebred classes. Registration papers are mandatory at check-in.
- Exhibitors must USE WATER ONLY on barrows when grooming for show. No oil or what appears to be oil or powder will be permitted.
